**Emergency Day Contingency:** If an emergency day should occur during exam week, the following procedure will go into effect: The week will be extended to equal the number of days missed. For example, if Wednesday would be an emergency day, then Wednesday's test would be given the first day back in school after the emergency day.

**Second Semester Advanced Placement Exemption:** Any Sophomore or Junior taking Advanced Placement tests during the second semester only will have the option of taking the class final or the AP test. Students must meet the discipline, academic and attendance criteria to opt out of the final exam.
