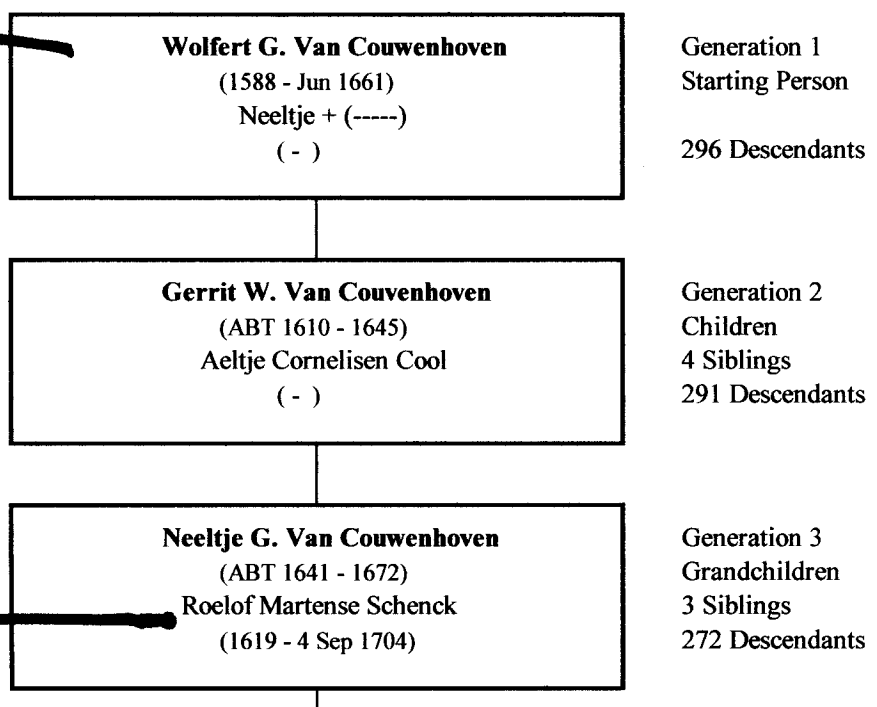

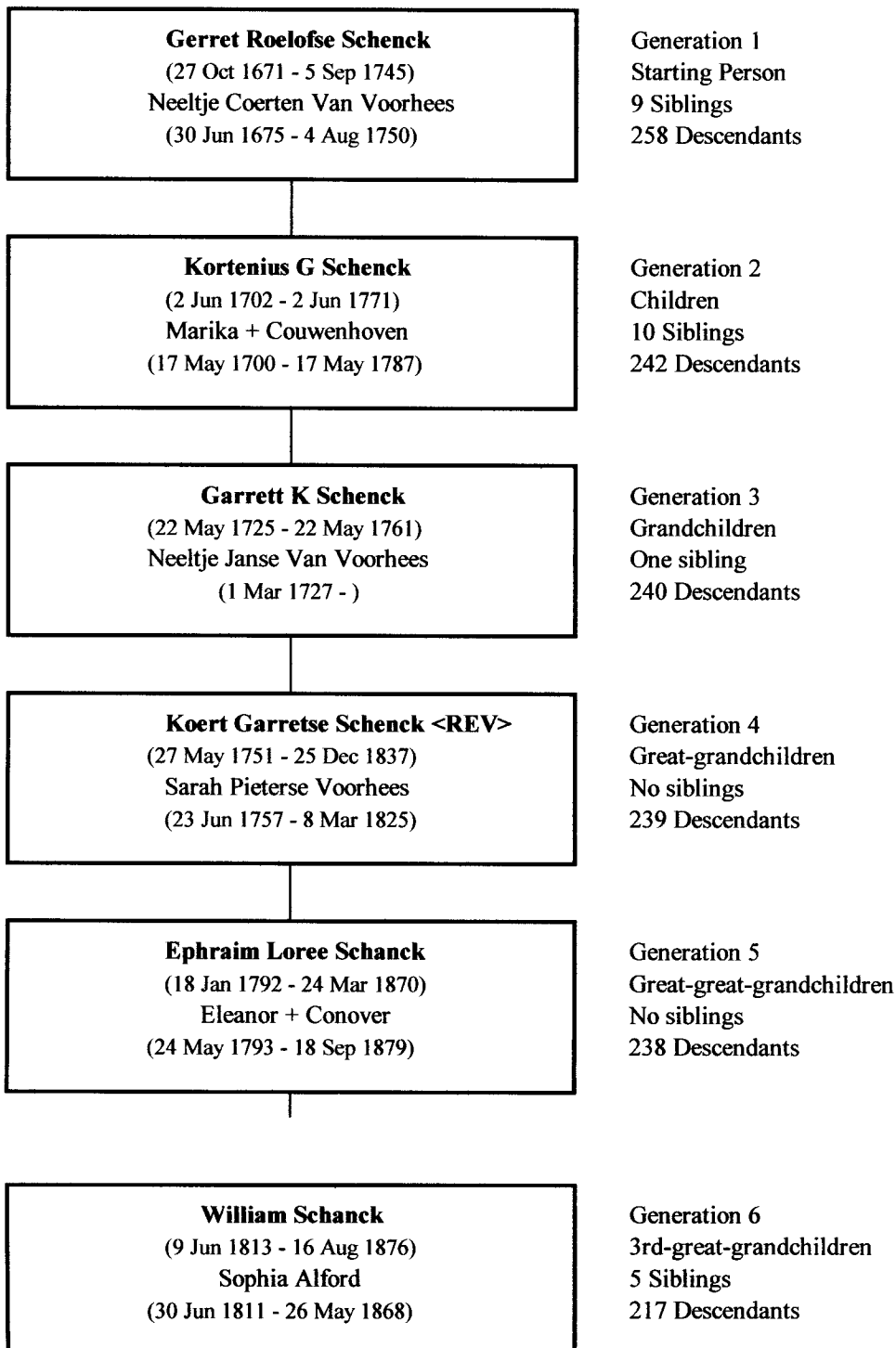
The First Three Generations
