# RECONNECTING WITH YOUR ARTIST SELF IN WATERCOLOR

Course No. ARTX 9006  
3 Semester Hours of Credit  
Tuition: \$285 - with all materials

## Course Description:

This course is conducted entirely by email. It is designed for teachers who have some watercolor experience and wish to experiment with more advanced watercolor techniques. The instructor, Caroline Buchanan, a renown watercolorist and instructor for many years, will take the participant on a thoughtful, introspective watercolor journey using wet-on-wet techniques, floating colors, glazing and "seeing" through words to inspire and motivate...taking the fear out and putting the energy in to a student's own unique work. The lessons and exercises will be ones the art teacher will be anxious to incorporate into his or her art classroom. Interface with the instructor will be available and encouraged.

## Course Outline:

Complete the required assignments using the instructor's guidelines and question formats. A minimum of 45 hours of work is required to receive three semester hours of professional development credit for this course.

## Method of Evaluating Student's Performance:

Course work will be evaluated by how closely the assignments adhere to the formats and topics assigned; as well as accuracy, originality and creativity, thoroughness, and critical thinking skills. A grade of credit (CR) or no credit (NC) will be issued upon completion and evaluation of course requirements. An official transcript for the semester hours earned will be issued upon request.

## Course Textbooks and Other Materials:

This course is conducted entirely by email. No books, tapes or other materials (except the participant's own watercolor supplies) are required. Upon enrollment, the student will receive an email from the instructor who will provide all assignments by way of attachments. Assignments will be emailed back to the instructor as attachments as they are completed. Interface with the instructor will be available and encouraged.
